

Fujairah Asia Power Company has entered into an agreement with Veolia Environment Research and Innovation Group to install a research facility at the F2 Power and Water plant in order to study the pretreatment of sea water affected by the Red Tide phenomena. This research will continue over the next 3 years with a possibility of finding a method to overcome the red tide without reducing or slowing production of potable water, using the reverse osmosis plant configuration. Veolia will provide 8 full time engineers and operators to conduct this research.

This facility is working with Azaliya, a Veolia and Mubadala company, who is operating the reverse osmosis facility at the F2 Plant.
